

Recycled Materials for art project!

You will be creating artwork with your class using recycled materials. You will be using these materials to create an imaginary animal with real animal traits.

Preparation:

1. Make a Base

Save a sturdy piece of cardboard from a box to use as your base. If the cardboard is brown and you'd prefer a white base, cut and glue on white pieces of paper.



2. Save Materials!

You can save any small, dry, and clean items that can be glued and stick to paper! Save them in a safe place to use during this activity. See the list below for ideas:

- Scrap paper – save scraps of any colored paper
- Twist ties
- Ribbon
- Bread tags
- Previously used art you don't plan on saving (we often "recovered" items from daycare projects).
- Colorful or fun looking packaging. You can cut it into manageable sized pieces.
- Bottle caps (these can be a little tricky to get to stick)
- You can also use small craft items.



3. Don't forget markers or crayons!
